Sub: Correspondence Course for Diploma in Railway Engineering - Examination for Semester-II (2017-2018) including Supplementary Examination for candidates who failed in previous Examination of Semester-II.

The undersigned is happy to inform that you have been admitted as a candidate in the main examination of Semester-II for the year 2017-2018. The receipt of your Demand Draft/Cash for examination Fee sent vide your application form is enclosed.

We are not issuing you a separate Admit Card giving allotment of Roll No. and Examination Centre, but admit card with Registration No. & Roll No. Issued at the time of admission to Semester- I 2017-18 will be valid for Second Semester examination 2017-18 also

The examination of Semester-II for the Session 2017-18 will be held on 15th and 16th December-2018 (Saturday and Sunday). The addresses of examination centre at Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, Chennai, Secunderabad, and Lucknow will be as under:

Some salient features of examination and its procedure are given below for your information.

2. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

(i) The student is allowed to appear in Semester-II examination even if he/she is unable to pass all the papers of Semester -I examination. However, only those students will be allowed to appear in Semester-II examination, who have appeared in the Semester-I examination irrespective of the fact whether they have passed or failed. It has also been laid down that Diploma Certificate will be awarded to the candidates only after passing in all the papers in Semester-I & II examinations.

(ii) Your Admit Card including your Enrollment No./Registration No., Roll No. and Centre etc. should be brought by you during the Examination. However under any unavoidable circumstances, if you are not in a position to appear at the centre as per the Admit Card, you can go and appear at any other Centre (out of those enlisted on page 1) by taking with you admit card and cash receipt towards payment of fee issued by this office. Necessary instructions in this regard have already been given to the Controlling Supervisors deputed at all the Centres.

(iii) As a special consideration it has been decided that such of the candidates who could not appear in any of the subjects or papers in Regular examination of Semester -II for the reasons whatsoever, may be allowed to appear in the Supplementary Examination of the same by paying fee of Rs.200/+GST @ 18% (Total Rs.236/) per subject limited to a maximum of Rs. 1000/-+GST @ 18% (Total Rs.1180/-) for all subjects in lump sum.

(iv) It has been decided that the examination paper may be attempted by the candidates in English or in Hindi or bilingually.

3. PASSING OF EXAMINATION:

The pass marks will be 34% in each paper. However if the candidate has failed in particular paper he/she can re-appear in the supplementary examination to be held in combination with Regular Examination of Semester-I &II of next session for passing in the papers in which he/she had failed last time, by paying fee @ Rs. 200/- per subject (Maximum Rs.1000/-)Plus GST@18% for Semester-I & II Supplementary examination . Application forms for this purpose will also be made available to the candidates on request from this office.

1. Please fill up various blanks on the Answer Book carefully and legibly. Each candidate should sign only at the place earmarked on the front page of the answer book.
2. Each paper should be answered on a separate Answer Book. All questions set in the question paper given to you in the examination hall are selected from the text of the lesson book already supplied to you. You are expected to explain your answers to each question in your own words and any effort to copy it from the lesson book or elsewhere verbatim will amount not only to award of 'Nil' marks but also cancellation of your admission to the examination.
3. Please write your Roll Number on the Answer Book. It will be the responsibility of each candidate that the Answer Book is handed over to the invigilator before leaving the Examination Hall.
4. Please ensure that you follow the timings as given in the question paper. No extra time will be allowed under any circumstances. The time of each paper is indicated on the Question Paper.
5. No candidate should copy or use unfair means in solving their questions. Any attempt to do so is likely to debar the candidate from appearing in the Examination and/or granting of nil marks for copied answers. No candidate should talk to other candidates during Examination period.
